\*Co-Ed divisions may be male and female players, and may have as few as one female player per team.

Equipment: All players are required to wear shin guards and bring a ball to practice.

### U6:

As a prerequisite to participating in this division, each player must provide an adult volunteer to coach one game and “officiate” one game per season. These games will be 4 vs. 4, with no goalies. There will be approx. six players on each team. Teams will not practice. Adults will receive instructions prior to the fall season.

### U8 thru U14:

Any player who provides a coach will receive a \$20 cash rebate\* at a mandatory coaching clinic. A maximum \$40 rebate per team may be issued. Coaches must attend the coaching clinic to receive the \$20 cash rebate. If you have multiple children on the same team, you may only take one \$20 rebate.

\*Not applicable to parent coaches in U6 division.

## Huntertown Lions Soccer Code of Conduct

Player(s) Name(s) \_\_\_\_\_

1. **Player Fighting:** Players guilty of fighting before, during, or after games shall receive a two-game suspension.
2. **Profanity:** Anyone guilty of using profanity either by word or gesture, against another player, coach, spectator, referee, assistant referee, or any League official shall receive a one-game suspension.
3. **Player Threats:** A player guilty of making threatening gestures against another player, coach, spectator, referee, assistant referee, or any League official shall receive a one-game suspension.
4. **Player Striking Official:** A player guilty of pushing or striking any coach, referee, assistant referee, or any League official shall to go before the Disciplinary Committee.
5. **Player Spitting:** A player guilty of spitting at or on anyone, including on one's own hand to shake with, shall receive a two-game suspension.
6. **Player Ejection:** Players sent off by the referee shall receive a minimum one-game suspension.
7. **Coach Threats:** Coaches or team officials who make threatening gestures or use threatening language to other players, coaches, League officials, referees, or assistant referees shall be disciplined: *First time*- two-game suspension, *Second time*- the offender shall appear before the Huntertown Lions Soccer Board and be suspended for four games, *Third time*-the offender will be suspended for not less than one year.
8. **Coach Fights:** Coaches or team officials who fight at any time shall be disciplined: *First time*- the offender shall appear before the Huntertown Lions Soccer Board and shall be suspended for a minimum of one year, *Second time*-the offender shall be suspended for not less than three years.
9. **Coach Misconduct:** Coaches and other team officials shall be subject to all rules pertaining to misconduct contained in this Huntertown Lions Soccer Code of Conduct, Huntertown Soccer Rules Book, and FIFA Laws of the Game, including cautions, send-offs, and standard suspensions.
10. **Fan (or Parent) Misconduct during Games and/or Practices:** Any fan (or parent) guilty of dissent, threatening behavior, or physical contact directed at any official, referee, coach, player, or other fan (or parent), according to the severity, will either be given a verbal warning and/or told to leave the field immediately, plus may be required to go before the Disciplinary Committee for additional Sanctions.

**Disciplinary Committee:** Will consist of the President, Coaching Chairman, Referee Chairman, Risk Management Chairman and an additional League Official.

**League Officials:** Huntertown Lions Soccer Board Members.
